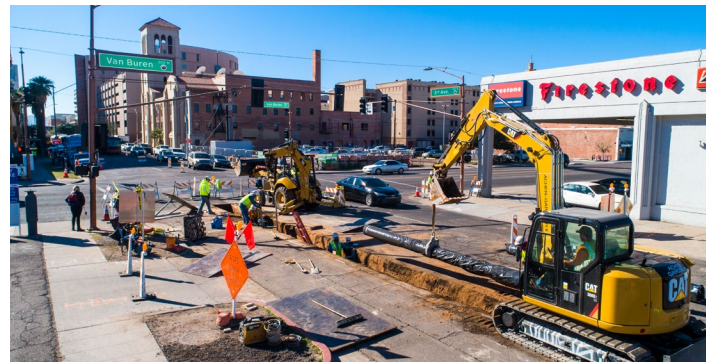


Debut of New Fuel Truck at ConExpo
