Achen-Gardner is known for constructing iconic streetscapes and artistic features throughout the Valley. One outstanding example is the "Tributary Wall" along Goldwater Boulevard south of Camelback Road in Scottsdale. Part of the City of Scottsdale's Indian School Road Improvements Project, the wall was completed January of 1999 received a Crescordia Award for Environmental Excellence from Valley Forward (now Arizona Forward). The wall, designed by artist Kevin Berry, features seven steel fish with perforated scale patterns that allow natural sunlight to filter through. The wall is a sound buffer for the nearby neighborhood and an artistic tribute to the area's cultural and natural history.


